THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, NOT THE STATES, WAS CHARGED WITH ENFORCEMENT, REVERSING THE PRIORITY OF THE ORIGINAL CONSTITUTION AND THE BILL OF RIGHTS. IN GRAFTING THE PRINCIPLE OF EQUALITY ONTO THE CONSTITUTION, THESE REVOLUTIONARY CHANGES MARKED THE SECOND FOUNDING OF THE UNITED STATES.
