During the 2013-2014 season, 17 of the 25 players of the first team were from La Masia, a historical record. These players, including Messi, Iniesta, and Xavi, have dazzled soccer fans around the world with their dance-like positioning and passing skills. La Masia now trains kids from all continents, including its first American, Ben Lederman. This book reveals that this accumulation of talent is not a coincidence but the

result of a 30 year-long plan, set in motion by the brilliant mind of Dutch coach and ex-Barça player Johan Cruyff. Cruyff brought to Barça the attacking, 4-3-3-based soccer style known as Total Football and converted La Masia into a high-throughput factory of players for the first team. Cruyff's brightest pupil, Pep Guardiola (from La Masia), became the coach that won three Ligas in a row and two Champions Leagues in four years with a team full of homegrown players. *The assistant soccer coach* - Denis Silva Puig 2020-06-13

The assistant soccer coach has existed for decades, and is a standard figure within the coaching staff, with specific roles, functions and responsibilities. However, I find it strange that nobody has yet described this profession formally. I

used to only be a head coach, until one day I was proposed to be the assistant coach of U18 team of FC Barcelona. That is when I started thinking about writing this book, moved by my desire to continue learning. If I wanted to train in my new role I could only do it by asking others and observing training sessions. But I was missing one of the pillars that has forever supported my training: studying and reading. With this book I hope to cover that lack of information. The book is divided into two parts: the first is based on describing the assistant coach in professional soccer and I have not found a more practical way to do it than through interviews with assistant coaches. Each interviewee has contributed his experiences from working with the most recognized soccer coaches: I am talking about people who have worked with Vicente del Bosque, Ernesto Valverde, Luis Enrique, Pep

Guardiola, Mauricio Pochettino, Sergio González, Quique Sánchez Flores, and Paulo Sousa. The second part of the book is related to Youth soccer, which I have experienced in clubs like Atlético de Madrid and FC Barcelona. I propose the role of the assistant coach working in Youth soccer to be more formative and educational than what is currently given, and I want to direct their effort towards two dimensions: the team's sporting performance (which the vast majority do) and the individualized analysis of the young player (which very few do). This second dimension is described in the last chapter, to demonstrate a new vision of assistant coaches in Youth soccer, who in my view have to dedicate their time to improving the players as an athlete and as a person in a more personalized and integral way.

Guardiola's first job as a full time coach was at FC Barcelona. At the time, the Barcelona Reserve Team or "Barcelona B" were doing very poorly, facing relegation. The club knew they needed to make a change, as the management mulled over possible replacements, but when the Directors of Barcelona found out Guardiola was interested in coaching, the choice was easy. Everyone at Barcelona held Pep in the highest regard, believing he would be a great coach. That belief would turn out to be correct, as Pep took over Barcelona B and didn't disappoint. He re-organized the training sessions, modernized the rondos, brought a relentless level of intensity to training and insisted on build-up play and possession, even on the tightest and smallest of fields. The results of Pep's efforts were seen immediately that first year, as Guardiola's Barcelona B won the league title. However, at the same

time that Pep's Barcelona B won the league, the Barcelona first team under Frank Rijkaard was struggling. They had all the big names and talent, but they were not playing well, failing to win any major titles. The club was at a crossroads, big decisions needed to be made to get Barcelona back to winning trophies. Barcelona were certainly impressed with Pep, but this was Barcelona after all, and Pep only had one year experience as a manager, and that was with the B team. The club President gave the issue a lot of thought, and in the end he decided to ask Pep if he was interested in the job; Pep responded by saying "you wouldn't have the balls....but with me you will win everything." The rest was history, as Barcelona would go on to win title after title under Guardiola. Pep would eventually leave Barcelona in 2012, having accomplished everything there was to accomplish with the club.....this



case study covers his entire managerial career along with Pep's ideas about management and soccer game model philosophies. It is a very short book but packed with powerful quotes and information. For any coach teaching positional soccer, it is more important to understand the ideas, then the actual training sessions.
