phenomenon to 19th century European utility-based painting; and poet and art critic John Yau contributes the perspective of an American art historian. Since there are no clear-cut rules, I based this book on a few simple guidelines. First, I excluded all silent films, for obvious reasons. Second, I excluded movies where the musical numbers were not performed

Finally, since this is a book of images, I tried to always give preference to posters that depict people singing or dancing.
