dari komponen inti yaitu (a) Tujuan Pembelajaran; (b) Kegiatan pembelajaran; dan (c) Asesment, dan kebijakan yang ke (4) terkait Peraturan Penerimaan Peserta Didik Baru (PPDB) zonasi Kemendikbud tetap menggunakan Sistem Zonasi dengan adaptasi yang lebih fleksibel untuk mengakomodasi ketimpangan akses dan kualitas diberbagai daerah. Daerah diberikan kewenangan dalam menentukan proporsi dan menetapkan wilayah zonasi.
