Die Nähe dieses Ideals zu den Voraussetzungen für ein zivilgesellschaftliches Engagement, ermöglicht eine Zusammenführung der beiden Konzepte. So kann die partizipative Medienarbeit in Community Radios unter bestimmten Voraussetzungen als demokratieförderndes, zivilgesellschaftliches Engagement bezeichnet werden. Die Arbeit fokussiert die Mitarbeiter der Community Radios. Sie befasst sich mit dem Erleben der normativen Ansprüche an zivilgesellschaftliches Engagement und deren Einordnung durch die Akteure in ihrem Sendealltag.

Labour in a Single Shot - Schwartz GRUNDMANN 2021-11-04

Indeed, the railway played a crucial role in the Holocaust by supporting the construction and operation of the Nazi death camps and by transporting Jews and other victims to them.

We illustrate how cardiopulmonary exercise testing can provide the means for a critical evaluation by the clinician-scientist of the functional competency of each component in the coupling of cellular to external respiration, including the cardiovascular system. Krankheitsbezogene Kapitel werden von Methodik (z.B. nicht-invasive Beatmung), Epidemiologie und Versorgungsforschung ergänzt. Im Bereich kardiovaskulärer Notfallmedizin gibt es z.T. relevante Unterschiede insbesondere in der klinischen Präsentation zwischen Frauen und Männern. Evidenzbasierte Unterschiede werden in jedem Kapitel in einer besonderen Infobox „Frauen“ hervorgehoben.
