H F W Taylor was for many years Professor of Inorganic Chemistry at the University of Aberdeen, Scotland. Since 1948, his main research interest has been the chemistry of cement. Returning to the form of *Stuff I've Been Feeling Lately*, *Sorry I Haven't Texted You Back* is a poetic mixtape dedicated to those who struggle or have struggled with their mental health. Divided into two parts, "Side A" holds 92 poems, titled as "tracks," and "Side B" holds the "remixes," or blackout-poetry versions, of those 92 poems. The book includes the evergreen themes of love, grief, and hope. Named after Cook's viral Instagram poem, *Sorry I Haven't Texted You Back* lands in the crossroads of self-help and poetry.
