There are a few instances of half barre chords (top three strings only), but even these are used sparingly. These arrangements utilize drones when appropriate (notably in *Pretty Saro* and *Hard Times Come Again No More*), and bass notes are frequently offset from strong beats (e.g.

bass notes landing on the and of the beat rather than on the beat). Although this style differs from many other guitar arrangements, this method of playing emphasizes the melody and allows the long, held bass notes (often open strings when possible) to fill out the soundscape. You'll find that rhythm is utilized to create a wonderfully full texture, rather than stacked notes as found in other guitar arrangements. This again is for the ease of reading and playability for the performer. As you become more comfortable with these arrangements, you will find areas where you could easily thicken the texture with some additional notes as you see fit.
