In this first of his two accounts, he tells how a tiny group of torture victims, clerics, and human-rights activists in Brazil launched an extremely risky, nonviolent plot to get even with the former torturers by publishing an indisputable account of their savage system of repression—indisputable because it is drawn from the regime's own files. In the second, set in Uruguay, he tells how a more broadly-based movement attempted to bring to light the dark history of a military regime engaged in more political incarceration per capita than any

other on earth at that time. In this illuminating and beautifully written book (portions of which appeared in five issues of *The New Yorker*), Weschler examines what a small number of individuals can do to retrieve history and truth from the hands of torturers.
