THE AUTHOR, DANIEL COQUILLETTE, THE FORMER DEAN OF BOSTON COLLEGE LAW SCHOOL, IS NOW THE J. DONALD MONAN S.J. UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR AT BOSTON COLLEGE AND THE LESTER KISSEL VISITING PROFESSOR AT HARVARD LAW SCHOOL. HE HAS SERVED AS CHAIRMAN OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAR ASSOCIATION COMMITTEE ON PROFESSIONAL ETHICS, AS A MEMBER OF THE ABA STANDING COMMITTEE ON ETHICS AND PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY, AND AS AN ADVISOR TO THE ALI RESTATEMENT OF THE LAW GOVERNING LAWYERS. RELYING ON YOUR INHERENT SENSE OF VIRTUE WILL NOT SAVE YOU FROM SERIOUS TROUBLE IF YOU ARE IGNORANT OF WHAT IS IN THIS BOOK. MOST COURSES ARE ABOUT HONING YOUR PROFESSIONAL SKILLS. THIS COURSE IS ABOUT PROFESSIONAL SURVIVAL. SOME WOULD ALSO SAY IT IS ABOUT ANOTHER KIND OF SURVIVAL THAT IS EVEN MORE IMPORTANT. HOW DO YOU SURVIVE AS A TRUE PROFESSIONAL, IN A TOUGH PROFESSIONAL WORLD, AND ALSO SURVIVE AS A PERSON?" CONCISELY AND PROVOCATIVELY WRITTEN, AND DESIGNED FOR A TWO OR THREE HOUR A WEEK COURSE, *REAL ETHICS FOR REAL LAWYERS* FILLS AN IMPORTANT GAP IN THE CURRENT SELECTION OF PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY CASEBOOKS.
