questions that are keyed to the major paragraphs of a TEMP, and an accompanying set of explanatory notes that are brief commentaries on the questions and the significance of the possible responses to them. The primary audience for this manual consists of those individuals who are responsible for evaluating TEMPs. However, it should also prove useful to program offices, independent test organizations, contractors, and others who review, prepare, or provide data for inclusion in TEMPs.
