SOUTHEAST ASIA COMMUNIST PARTIES WERE ALSO THE OBJECT OF A GREAT DEAL OF ANALYSIS BOTH DURING AND AFTER THESE CONFLICTS. SOME RELEVANT DOCUMENTS WHICH ARE CITED IN THE BOOK AND MARK THE ERA, BUT WHICH ARE OFTEN DIFFICULT TO ACCESS, HAVE ALSO BEEN ASSEMBLED AS APPENDICES.
