Unified Communication ist als Verbesserung und

Erweiterung von Unified Messaging zu sehen. Ein Vergleich zu Unified Messaging betont die Vorteile von Unified Communication. Im dritten Kapitel werden die besonderen Fähigkeiten von Unified Communication vorgestellt. Diese Charakteristika findet man in Umsetzungen von Siemens und Avaya wieder, die im letzten Kapitel erläutert werden.
