ARMED WITH THE ARGUMENTS, HALPER IS ABLE TO SEE ARISTOTLE’S CHARACTERISTIC DOCTRINES AS CONCLUSIONS. THESE LATTER ARE, FOR THE MOST PART, SUPPORTED BY SHOWING THAT THEY RESOLVE OTHERWISE INSOLUBLE PROBLEMS. MOREOVER, HAVING ARISTOTLE’S ARGUMENTS ENABLES HALPER TO DELIMIT THOSE DOCTRINES AND TO RESOLVE THE APPARENT CONTRADICTION IN ARISTOTLE’S ACCOUNT OF PRIMARY OUSIA, THE CLASSIC PROBLEM OF THE CENTRAL BOOKS. ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO WAY TO MAKE THE METAPHYSICS EASY, THIS VERY THOROUGH TREATMENT OF THE TEXT SUCCEEDS IN MAKING IT SURPRISINGLY INTELLIGIBLE.
