In fact the collection of books by late seventeenth and early eighteenth century European authors on, for example, such subjects as biblical criticism, political and religious controversy, is one of the richest parts of the Library's collections. Marsh's at least 5,000 English books or books printed in England were printed between 1640 and 1700.
