IDEALISM' AND WALTZ'S FROM THOSE OF 'COMPLACENT IDEALISM'. IN CONTRAST, HEDLEY BULL'S ANALYSIS OF INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY IS BASED ON A MORE REALISTIC UNDERSTANDING OF WORLD POLITICS.
