Included in the book is biographical information; commission, duration, instrumentation, date of publication, premiere, publisher, discography for each piece; bibliographical sources; and an index which groups the music by numbers, medium, and ensemble. This is the fourth volume in Aaron Horne's monumental effort to provide the most comprehensive guide to music composed by black composers. In this volume he covers composers from around the world in the 19th and 20th centuries, including William Grant Still, Ulysses Kay, Anthony Davis, John Coltrane, and other major figures from the world of classical, jazz, and popular music. The main body of the book is

divided into sections devoted to African, African American, Afro-European, and Afro-Latino composers. Within each section composers are arranged alphabetically; each entry provides biographical information as well as commission, duration, instrumentation, date of publication, premiere, publisher, discography for each composition. Backmatter includes a Brass Music Index which groups the music by numbers, medium, and ensembles; a title index; discography; and bibliography. As with the earlier volumes, this is an essential reference tool for anyone with an interest in researching and/or performing the music of black composers.

Composed during the years 2003-2004 by David Bilskemper, this piece, the saxophone concerto, was completed during a life transition. Long awaiting publication, the piece as a full score edition is now

available in this format. The saxophone writing in the piece pushes limits and boundaries on the instrument to the maximum potential almost of what was thought possible in terms of range and duration. Early on the prospects for a chamber orchestra version were forsaken in favor of this instrumentation- the composition for full orchestra and saxophone.

**Triple Concerto No. 1** - Dmitri Smirnov 2017-11-22

Dmitri N. Smirnov Triple Concerto No. 1, Op. 21 (1977) for alto saxophone, piano, double bass, strings and percussion. To the 5th anniversary of my and my wife's wedding I wrote a little piece for alto saxophone on musical letters D-(e)S-E-F (for Dmitri Smirnov and Elena Firsova). But it was too short to be a completed and independent piece, and thinking how to develop it, I found myself working on a 3-movement concerto for 3 soloists, strings and percussion, with the lyrical First Movement (Lento), 3 cadenzas as the Second Movement (Risoluto), and fast Finale (Allegro). It was premiered on 26th December 1977 at the Union of Composers in Moscow with Lev Mikhailov (saxophone), Alexander Bakhchiev (piano), Ivan Kotov (double bass) and Moscow Chamber Orchestra conducted by Lev Markiz.
