A petition seeking to bring before the electorate a question regarding the dissolution of a

city of the third class pursuant to K.S.A. 15-111 must comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-3601 et seq., except to the extent that K.S.A. 15-111 imposes specific requirements that conflict with those requirements set forth in K.S.A.

25-3601 et seq. Such a petition is to be filed with the county election officer of the county in which the city is located and must include signatures equal in number to not less than a majority of the latest voter registration certified by the county election officer to the Secretary of State. The election at which a question regarding the status of a city of the third class is submitted to the electorate pursuant to K.S.A. 15-111 and 25-3601 et seq. is to be held at the next succeeding primary or general election, as defined by K.S.A. 25-2502, in which the city is participating. The provisions in Chapter 25 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated are to be followed when conducting such an election, however the obligation to count ballots cast in the election is placed upon the city council.
