THE WORLD IS IN A TERRIBLE MESS. IT IS TOXIC, IRRADIATED, AND FULL OF INJUSTICE. AIMING TO STAND ASIDE FROM THE MESS CAN PRODUCE A SEEMINGLY SATISFYING SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS IN THE SCANT MOMENTS WE ACHIEVE IT, BUT SINCE IT IS ULTIMATELY IMPOSSIBLE, INDIVIDUAL PURITY WILL ALWAYS DISAPPOINT. PROPOSING A POWERFUL NEW CONCEPTION OF SOCIAL MOVEMENTS AS CUSTODIANS FOR THE PAST AND INCUBATORS FOR LIBERATED FUTURES, AGAINST PURITY UNDERTAKES AN ANALYSIS THAT DRAWS ON THEORIES OF RACE, DISABILITY, GENDER, AND ANIMAL ETHICS AS A FOUNDATION FOR AN

INNOVATIVE APPROACH TO THE POLITICS AND ETHICS OF RESPONDING TO SYSTEMIC PROBLEMS. BEING AGAINST PURITY MEANS THAT THERE IS NO PRIMORDIAL STATE WE CAN RECOVER, NO EDEN WE HAVE DESECRATED, NO PRETOXIC BODY WE MIGHT UNCOVER THROUGH ENOUGH CHIA SEEDS AND KOMBUCHA. THERE IS NO PRERACIAL STATE WE COULD ACCESS, NO ERASING HISTORIES OF SLAVERY, FORCED LABOR, COLONIALISM, GENOCIDE, AND THEIR CONCOMITANT RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS. THERE IS NO FOOD WE CAN EAT, CLOTHES WE CAN BUY, OR ENERGY WE CAN USE WITHOUT DEEPENING OUR TIES TO COMPLEX WEBBINGS OF SUFFERING. SO, WHAT HAPPENS IF WE START FROM THERE? ALEXIS SHOTWELL SHOWS THE IMPORTANCE OF CRITICAL MEMORY PRACTICES TO ADDRESSING THE FULL IMPLICATIONS OF LIVING ON COLONIZED LAND; HOW ACTIVISM LED TO THE OFFICIAL RECLASSIFICATION OF AIDS; WHY WE MIGHT WORRY ABOUT STUDYING AMPHIBIANS WHEN WE TRY TO FIGHT INDUSTRIAL CONTAMINATION; AND THAT WE ARE ALL AFFECTED BY NUCLEAR REACTOR MELTDOWNS. **BEYOND EDUCATION - ELI MEYERHOFF 2019-07-23**

A BOLD CALL TO DEROMANTICIZE EDUCATION AND REFRAME UNIVERSITIES AS TERRAINS OF STRUGGLE BETWEEN ALTERNATIVE MODES OF STUDYING AND WORLD-MAKING HIGHER EDUCATION IS AT AN IMPASSE. BLACK LIVES MATTER AND #MeToo SHOW THAT RACISM AND SEXISM REMAIN PERVASIVE ON CAMPUS, WHILE STUDENT AND FACULTY MOVEMENTS FIGHT TO REVERSE INCREASED TUITION, STUDENT DEBT, CORPORATIZATION, AND ADJUNCTIFICATION. COMMENTATORS TYPICALLY FRAME THESE ISSUES AS CRISES FOR AN OTHERWISE OPTIMAL MODE OF INTELLECTUAL AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT. IN BEYOND EDUCATION, ELI MEYERHOFF INSTEAD SEES THIS IMPASSE AS INHERENT TO UNIVERSITIES, AS SITES OF INTERSECTING POLITICAL STRUGGLES OVER RESOURCES FOR STUDYING. MEYERHOFF ARGUES THAT THE PREDOMINANT MODE OF STUDY, EDUCATION, IS ONLY ONE AMONG MANY ALTERNATIVES AND THAT IT MUST BE DEROMANTICIZED IN ORDER TO RECOGNIZE IT AS A COLONIAL-CAPITALIST INSTITUTION. HE TRACES HOW KEY ELEMENTS OF EDUCATION—THE VERTICAL TRAJECTORY OF INDIVIDUALIZED DEVELOPMENT, ITS ROLE IN PREPARING PEOPLE TO PARTICIPATE IN GOVERNANCE THROUGH A PEDAGOGICAL MODE OF ACCOUNTING, AND DICHOTOMOUS FIGURES OF EDUCATIONAL WASTE (THE “DROPOUT”) AND

VALUE (THE “GRADUATE”)—EMERGED FROM HISTORIES OF STRUGGLES IN OPPOSITION TO ALTERNATIVE MODES OF STUDY BOUND UP WITH DIFFERENT MODES OF WORLD-MAKING. THROUGH INTERVIEWS WITH PARTICIPANTS IN CONTEMPORARY UNIVERSITY STRUGGLES AND EMBEDDED RESEARCH WITH AN ANARCHIST FREE UNIVERSITY, *BEYOND EDUCATION PAVES NEW AVENUES FOR ACHIEVING THE AIMS OF AN “ALTER-UNIVERSITY” MOVEMENT TO PUT NOVEL MODES OF STUDY INTO PRACTICE. TAKING INSPIRATION FROM BLACK LIVES MATTER, OCCUPY WALL STREET, AND INDIGENOUS RESURGENCE PROJECTS, IT CHARTS A NEW COURSE FOR MOVEMENTS WITHIN, AGAINST, AND BEYOND THE UNIVERSITY AS WE KNOW IT.*

**WHO WAS HARRIET TUBMAN?** - YONA ZELDIS McDONOUGH 2002-12-30

BORN A SLAVE IN MARYLAND, HARRIET TUBMAN KNEW FIRST-HAND WHAT IT MEANT TO BE SOMEONE’S PROPERTY; SHE WAS WHIPPED BY OWNERS AND ALMOST KILLED BY AN OVERSEER. IT WAS FROM OTHER FIELD HANDS THAT SHE FIRST HEARD ABOUT THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD WHICH SHE TRAVELLED BY HERSELF NORTH TO PHILADELPHIA. THROUGHOUT HER LONG LIFE (SHE DIED AT THE AGE OF NINETY-TWO) AND LONG AFTER THE CIVIL WAR BROUGHT AN END TO SLAVERY, THIS AMAZING WOMAN WAS PROOF OF WHAT JUST ONE PERSON CAN DO.

### **THE ENLIGHTENMENT OF JOSEPH PRIESTLEY - ROBERT E.**

SCHOFIELD 1997-01-01

JOSEPH PRIESTLEY (1733-1804) IS ONE OF THE MAJOR FIGURES OF THE ENGLISH ENLIGHTENMENT. A CONTEMPORARY AND FRIEND OF BENJAMIN FRANKLIN AND THOMAS JEFFERSON, HE EXCEEDED EVEN THESE POLYMATHS IN THE BREADTH OF HIS CURIOSITY AND LEARNING. YET NO ONE HAS ATTEMPTED AN ALL-INCLUSIVE BIOGRAPHY OF PRIESTLEY, PROBABLY BECAUSE HE WAS SIMPLY TOO MANY PERSONS FOR ANYONE EASILY TO COMPREHEND IN A SINGLE STUDY. ROBERT SCHOFIELD HAS DEVOTED A LIFETIME OF SCHOLARSHIP TO THIS TASK. THE RESULT IS A MAGISTERIAL BOOK, COVERING THE LIFE AND WORKS OF PRIESTLEY DURING THE CRITICAL FIRST FORTY YEARS OF HIS LIFE. ALTHOUGH PRIESTLEY IS BEST KNOWN AS A CHEMIST, THIS BOOK IS CONSIDERABLY MORE THAN A STUDY IN THE HISTORY OF SCIENCE. AS ANY GOOD BIOGRAPHER MUST, SCHOFIELD HAS THOROUGHLY STUDIED THE MANY ACTIVITIES IN WHICH PRIESTLEY WAS ENGAGED. AMONG THEM ARE THEOLOGY, ELECTRICITY, CHEMISTRY, POLITICS, ENGLISH GRAMMAR, RHETORIC, AND EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY. SCHOFIELD SITUATES PRIESTLEY, THE PROVINCIAL DISSENTER, WITHIN THE SOCIAL, POLITICAL, AND INTELLECTUAL CONTEXTS OF HIS DAY AND EXAMINES ALL THE WORKS PRIESTLEY WROTE AND PUBLISHED DURING THIS PERIOD. SCHOFIELD SINGLES OUT THE FIRST FORTY YEARS OF PRIESTLEY'S LIFE BECAUSE THESE WERE THE YEARS OF

PREPARATION AND TRIAL DURING WHICH PRIESTLEY QUALIFIED FOR THE ACHIEVEMENTS THAT WERE TO MAKE HIM FAMOUS. THE DISCOVERY OF OXYGEN, THE DEFENSES OF UNITARIANISM, AND THE POLITICAL LIBERALISM THAT CHARACTERIZE THE MATURE PRIESTLEY—ALL ARE FORESHADOWED IN THE YOUNG PRIESTLEY. A BRIEF EPILOGUE LOOKS AHEAD TO THE NEXT THIRTY YEARS WHEN PRIESTLEY WAS FORCED OUT OF ENGLAND AND SETTLED IN PENNSYLVANIA, THE SUBJECT OF SCHOFIELD'S NEXT BOOK. BUT THIS VOLUME STANDS ALONE AS THE DEFINITIVE STUDY OF THE MAKING OF JOSEPH PRIESTLEY.

FIXED AND LESS CERTAIN, MAKING IDENTITY ISSUES BOTH MORE SALIENT AND MORE INTERESTING. PARTICULAR ATTENTION HAS BEEN GIVEN TO PROCESSES OF IDENTITY CONSTRUCTION, OFTEN STYLED 'IDENTITY WORK'. RESEARCH HAS FOCUSED ON HOW, WHY, AND WHEN SUCH PROCESSES OCCUR, AND THEIR IMPLICATIONS FOR ORGANIZING AND INDIVIDUAL, GROUP, AND ORGANIZATIONAL OUTCOMES. THIS HAS RESULTED IN A BURGEONING STREAM OF RESEARCH FROM DISCURSIVE, DRAMATURGICAL, SYMBOLIC, SOCIO-COGNITIVE, AND PSYCHODYNAMIC PERSPECTIVES THAT MOST OFTEN CASTS INDIVIDUALS' EFFORTS TO FABRICATE IDENTITIES AS INTENTIONAL, RELATIONAL, AND CONSEQUENTIAL.
