AS ONE GETS DEEPER INTO THEORY, THE CONFLICTS CAN GET MORE COMPLICATED IN TERMS OF WHERE A “ROOT” NOTE MIGHT LAY IN A CHORD SEQUENCE, OR HOW A CHORD MIGHT FIT IN A PARTICULAR SCALE. DAVIS SEEKS TO SOLVE THAT QUANDARY WITH A PRACTICAL STANDARD FOR WORKING GUITARISTS.
