The Annexation of Eupen-Malmedy - Vincent O'Connell 2017-11-16

This book examines the history of Belgium's annexation of the former German territories of Eupen and Malmedy during the interwar period. Focusing on Herman Baltia's transitory regime and Belgium's ambivalence about the fate of its new territories, the book charts the strained relations between Baltia's regime and Brussels, the regime's path to dissolution, and the failed

retrocession of the territory to Germany. Through close analysis of primary source material, Vincent O'Connell investigates the efforts of Baltia's provisional government to assimilate the region's inhabitants into Belgium. The ultimate failure of that assimilation, he argues, may be traced back not only to incessant pro-German agitation, but to flawed Belgian policy from the outset. Framed in the context of a post-Versailles Europe, the book offers an interesting case study not only of the ebbs and flows of international politics across the frontier zones of Europe in the interwar years, but of how populations react to changes in national sovereignty.

Die deutschsprachigen Einwohner Belgiens besitzen im belgischen Staatsgefüge eine rechtlich abgesicherte Stellung mit einer beträchtlichen

politischen Autonomie. Diese stellt den vorläufigen Schlusspunkt einer bewegten Vergangenheit am Schnittpunkt mehrerer Kulturräume und an den Grenzen mehrerer Staaten dar. Die Fokussierung hierauf und die damit verbundenen selbstgenügsamen Einigelungstendenzen haben jedoch zur Verdrängung der Frage geführt, was über den formellen Status hinaus ihre Identität ausmacht und sie von ihren Nachbarn unterscheidet, von denen sie sich bewusst abgrenzen wollen, obwohl sie ihnen in vielerlei Hinsicht ähnlich sind. In diesem Buch werden die verschiedenen Identitätsdimensionen systematisch und kritisch untersucht, und dabei auch geläufige Selbstbilder hinterfragt, insbesondere auch mit Blick darauf, welches Potenzial sie für die weitere Entwicklung bieten. Auf dieser Grundlage wird ein Perspektivwechsel empfohlen und in seinen Grundzügen dargestellt. Ausgehend von den Merkmalen der Deutschsprachigen in einem

weiteren kulturellen und regionalen Kontext werden neue Sichtweisen auf das Eigene und das größere Ganze in einer zukunftsorientierten Denkhaltung entwickelt. Dabei wird kein fertiges Modell vorgestellt, wohl aber aufgezeigt, welche identitätsprägenden Eigenschaften auf einer inhaltlichen Ebene positive Bestandteile einer Identität der deutschsprachigen Belgier darstellen können.

When Monsignor Thomas J. Green, professor at the School of Canon Law at The Catholic University of America, approached his seventy-fifth birthday and the fiftieth anniversary of his priestly ordination, his colleagues planned on offering him a fitting tribute in the form of a festschrift. Six people with

different backgrounds, but all related to Msgr. Green on one way or another, have written a laudatio - a short congratulatory letter - in honor of Monsignor Green.
