The Life that Wins - Watchman Nee 1986

Do you know the life that wins? Are you ashamed of the kind of Christian life you live? Have you failed so terribly in your striving for victory that you cry out, "Wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me . . . ?" (Rom. 7.24) Be assured that your salvation is at hand: "thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord" (v.25). For the life that wins is not attained, but obtained. It is not a life changed, but rather a life exchanged. It is not suppression, only expression. It is frankly not in you yourself, because it is in Christ who lives in you. The life which God gives and you receive at the time you believe in His Son Jesus Christ is such a life. It is a life that overcomes sin, provides intimate communion with God, and is full of satisfaction and power. It is already in you, waiting to be explored by you. The secret towards experiencing its power is to let go of yourself and let Christ live instead of you.

This requires a childlike faith. Then shall you more than conquer through Him who loves you. In order to help believers into enjoying this life that wins, Watchman Nee delivered a series of messages on this subject at a conference held in Shanghai, China, in the months of September and October, 1935. He dealt with the full range of this important subject in his usual thoroughness yet simplicity and directness. At that conference, the author began with the believer's personal experience which, shamefully, is much less than desired. Then, by contrast, he described the kind of Christian life as ordained by God. Next, he dealt with the nature of this life that wins before he showed the way of entering into it. In more detail, he treated the matters of yielding and believing, which are the conditions for crossing the threshold of victory. But the author of these messages then warned his audience of the testing of faith which must follow. He exhorted believers to grow in the grace of Jesus Christ. He stressed also the need for having the note of triumph, which is praise. And finally, he concluded with the first and last act after victory, which is consecration. These messages are now being translated from the Chinese for the first time and presented to the readers in book form. May the Lord of glory be glorified through His life being lived out in His own.

For "every scripture is divinely inspired [God-breathed], and profitable for teaching, for conviction, for correction, for instruction in righteousness; that the man of God may be complete, fully fitted to every good work" (II Timothy 3:16-17). "Ye search the scriptures," said the Lord Jesus Christ, "for ye think that in them ye have life eternal, and they it is which bear witness concerning me; and ye will not come to me that ye might have life" (John 5:39-40). It behooves us, therefore, to diligently read the Bible and meditate on it. To encourage God's people to study God's word, brother Stephen Kaung delivered a series of messages on the sixty-six books of the Bible. Commencing in 1983, each Lord's day the survey of one book was shared from the New Testament; and a similar sharing from the Old Testament commenced in 1986. Each message is merely a panoramic view of each book of the Bible; a tasting of the sweetness of God's word. The aim is to provide the saints with some basic understanding in their search of God's word. These being spoken messages, no acknowledgement of the names of the many commentaries consulted is indicated. This survey of the Holy Bible will be published as Volume I and Volume II under the overall title of *God Has Spoken*: with Volume I bearing the subtitle, *Seeing Christ in the Old Testament*, and consisting of two physical volumes, Part One (Genesis to Song of Songs) and Part Two (Isaiah to Malachi); and Volume II bearing the subtitle, *Seeing Christ in the New Testament*. No Longer Zombies But Complete in Christ Volume 2 - Rika Geldenhuis 2019-07-17

This book discusses how the sound waves and lyrics of music, such as Rock 'n' Roll and Trance, have an influence on a person's body, soul and spirit. A person's eyes and ears bring messages of the outside world inside a person. These messages go directly to the brain. These messages can either be positive or negative messages. The frontal lobe of the brain is where reasoning takes place. The frontal lobe is the place where a person's thought processes start.

Thoughts will therefore also be either positive, or negative - depending on the messages received. Good thoughts (positive) and bad thoughts (negative) are then stored together in a person's memory basis. These thoughts form a belief system about oneself, God and the world. One's belief system can be formed by the messages received from parents, peer groups, role models, the lyrics in music, the social media, etc. The memory basis is linked to the hypothalamus (emotional centre). A person will "feel" his thoughts: Think positive, feel positive and think negative, feel negative. Good thoughts will produce good feelings and bad thoughts will produce bad feelings. The hypothalamus sends the messages to the pituitary gland which produces chemicals and the nerves "feed" the whole body. Good thoughts produce good feelings and the "happy" hormone, serotonin, is provoked. Bad, evil, or negative thoughts produce bad, evil or negative feelings and endorphins like adrenalin will be provoked. Endorphins are highly addictive, therefore one can get addicted to the stimuli which activated these hormones. One can get addicted to the music, which activated serotonin, or adrenalin. The sound waves of heavy music, such as Heavy metal and Death metal, have sharp points and aggravate feelings of frustration and anger and adrenalin is activated. Smooth music's sound waves have round curves and make people experience feelings of peace and happiness and serotonin is activated. When the eyes and ears of a person receive God's Word, God plants his "flowers" in the memory basis, but when the eyes and ears receive evil messages, Satan plants his "weeds." God's good Word will form a positive belief system and Satan's bad, evil and negative messages, will form a negative belief

system. One perceives the outside world from inside. Negative thoughts can cause nihilism - feelings of worthlessness. Stress caused by negative messages, can cause illnesses like ulcers, high blood pressure, migrains, etc. God's good words can, therefore, heal a person. "Ephraim is a cake not turned" (Hosea 7.8). This is a figurative way of saying 'not balanced'. The cake is burned on the one side, uncooked on the other; on one side it is overdone, on the other, totally undone. The cake is unfit to be eaten and is thus destined to be cast out. Our God is most balanced. He is love and He is light. Our Lord Jesus is full of grace and full of truth. The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of wisdom as well as of revelation. In creation, God "hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with a span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and the hills in a balance" (Is. 40.12). Concerning redemption, it is said that "mercy and truth are met together, righteousness and peace have kissed each other. Truth springeth out of the earth; and righteousness hath looked down from heaven" (Ps. 85.10,11). The new creation, therefore, must be well balanced. In

this present volume, Watchman Nee attempts to show from God's word the perfect equilibrium of divine truth. Human nature, however, is prone to emphasize one side to the exclusion of the other side of truth. This has caused much confusion and many problems among God's people. It is essential that we know the balance of truth and hold on to both sides so that our Christian life may be well rounded as God has ordained. The contents of the book opens with a treatment of the balance between the gate and the way; continues with a presentation of the balance between the objective and the subjective; includes a discussion on the work inward and the work outward in the Christian life, as well as on the rest given and the rest found as promised by Christ; contemplates the other side of prayer frequently neglected, namely, to watch; and concentrates on the other less emphasized aspect of the trespass-offering, that of restoration. The book then provides a commentary on the contrast between the truly meek

and the spiritually poor, and finally concludes with a consideration of the equilibrium that is so necessary between the believer's faith and the believer's walk. May all who read this volume be brought into a balanced Christian life.
