The nature of the problem itself, Howe explains, has privileged scientists as the primary spokespeople for the global climate. But while the science-first forms of advocacy they developed to fight global warming produced more and better science, the primacy of science in global warming politics has failed to produce meaningful results. In fact, an often exclusive focus on science has left advocates for change vulnerable to political opposition and has limited much of the discussion to debates about the science itself. As a result, while we know much more about global warming than we did fifty years ago, CO₂ continues to rise. In 1958, Keeling first measured CO₂ at around 315 parts per million; by 2013, global CO₂ had soared to 400 ppm. The problem is not getting better - it's getting worse. *Behind the Curve* offers a critical and levelheaded look at how we got here.
