academic discipline, including history. Students should be encouraged to
look up words that they do not know when they encounter them while
reading. Students will not do formal vocabulary activities in this course, but
a glossary has been provided for words that the students may find difficult
or unfamiliar in the assigned reading. Upon encountering an unknown
word, the student should consult the glossary provided at the back of the
teacher guide and/or a dictionary. Students should also be aware that
many of these words have multiple meanings. It is important that students
learn to use the context of these words in the text to help understand their
meanings. Students are encouraged to maintain a list of these words and
review them periodically throughout the course. Review could include
writing the words and their definitions on index cards to use as flashcards,
